We will be developing the way we have been assigning work for students to allow for greater interaction and monitoring of work completed.

Over the next few weeks, teachers will post work for students to complete on the school website (working from home button). This will be available from Monday morning. We will also be using Seesaw (<http://seesaw.me>)

This is a secure online journal where students can document and reflect on what they are learning at home. Your child will be able to add the things we work on (including videos, photos, worksheets, drawings and voice recordings) to their Seesaw journal. Each class will have their own Seesaw Journal which can only be viewed by their teachers.

In order for your child to use Seesaw, the app needs your child's name in order to be able to associate work like their photos, voice recordings or videos with their account. Seesaw only uses this information to provide the service and doesn't advertise in Seesaw, create profiles of students, or share or sell your child's personal information or journal content.
